Greetings from Cambodia! Good News or Bad News: Which Do You Want First? Let me start off by saying thank you so much for taking the time to read our latest update. Thy and I sure do appreciate and covet your continual love, prayers, and support for our family and ministry. The month of April 2021 will go down as one of the strangest since we arrived here 9 years ago. Yet, at the same time, God continues to prove Himself faithful over and over again. I'll do my best to make this letter short and sweet!

The Bad News: In our last update, I mentioned that Cambodia experienced its 3<sup>rd</sup> community outbreak since the global pandemic began. For about a year, Cambodia did a wonderful job of containing the virus; but since then, things have taken a turn for the worst as Cambodia went from little confirmed positive cases and no deaths to 12,641 positive cases and 92 deaths (confirmed as of Thursday, April 30th). I also mentioned that the capital city in which we live in was placed on lockdown; this past month our village in particular (Trapang Snor) was also placed on lockdown (meaning: only going out to the nearest local market for essentials 2 to 3 times a week). Our family, team and ministry here are usually very active in reaching the lost, teaching and training believers; if you could please pray for us to have wisdom, favor, mercy, and courage as we continue to trust God during these uncertain times.

The Good News: Though we understand that nothing will ever replace the church meeting together in person and also active outdoor evangelism, we praise God for the technology to be able to encourage, equip, and edify the national believers and also share the gospel with the lost for the time being. The funny thing is that now I am discipling more people than ever! Folks that I was able to lead to the Lord these past few years, many of whom I was not able to disciple due to various reasons are now being grounded in the Word online! We also started an online Bible study group for our Preah Vihear ministry. I continue to be in awe of how hungry and humble our national believers are in growing spiritually and in awe of the Greatness of our God, particularly how He is always at work in us, through us, and all around us! Please be in prayer for us to continue to grow in grace and truth. Lastly, I would like to share with you that Roth believed on Jesus this past month. I appreciate many of you who have prayed for his salvation. Please also pray for his wife, Srey Mao, to be saved. Also, continue to pray for doors of opportunities for us to share the good news of our Lord Jesus!
