I apologize for missing the December letter, no excuses, it was a mistake on my part. Covid, since most conversations start that way nowadays, started our trip off with complications. I'll spare you all the details and just say our first two weeks here were spent looking to God saying what should we do now! Obviously, His ways are always better than ours and we watched Him take care of everything as only He can. We are now driving a reliable vehicle and God has met so many other needs that we once again sit back and say, "What a mighty God we serve!"

Our meetings this trip have been so wonderfully encouraging. We have been able to report to many supporting churches as well as visit some new ones. We have picked up two new supporting churches! In our video, I mention our need to renovate our building because of extensive termite damage. We have raised over \$2000 towards that project.

My wife and I have both gotten Covid and are just fine. Sarah also had a more serious scare when we found a lump. She had it tested, and they said it is non-cancerous! The radiologist did want to recheck it at 6 months which would extend our stay by a month. With that in mind, I contacted the family that has been filling in for us on Guam and let them know our situation. Unfortunately, they are unable to extend their stay. I was beginning to brainstorm about how to fill that month when another family called to check in with us. After an hour, we had plans for them to cover that month on Guam for us. After planning things out further we have moved our departure date back to Guam to the 8th of June.

The ministry on Guam has been well taken care of with Brother Andrews filling the pulpit. A few of the children and one of the dads have made professions of faith. We are getting more and more homesick for Guam as the days go by, especially with the cold weather! However, our task here has been blessed and we still have more work to do until we can return. Please pray about giving toward the need for the building, and for the families who are gracious enough to stand in our place while we are here in the states.
